The Scholarship Program

The Scholarship Program was established in 2013 and is offered to a current high school senior, college freshman or college sophomore who is in good academic standing, demonstrates leadership, community service, is of good character, and interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement/criminal justice. The \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in two installments of \$500.

Qualifications

- US citizenship
- State of Texas resident
- High school senior, college freshman or college sophomore (in 2018-2019 school year)
- 3.0 grade point average or higher
- Attending or planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college/university in the Fall of 2019
- Dependents of FBI employees are not eligible to apply

- Complete application packets will contain the following: application form, two letters of recommendation, copy of most recent transcript and an essay.

Award

The recipient will be announced in April 2019. He or she will receive the first installment upon providing documentation of registration from the college/university stated on their application. The second installment will be provided upon registration documentation for the second semester.
