



## **Federal Bureau of Investigation Dallas Citizens Academy Alumni Association 2020 Scholarship Program**

The FBI Dallas Citizens Academy Alumni Association (FBI Dallas CAAA) is dedicated to supporting the mission of the FBI in its outreach programs within the community and serve alongside them as private sector ambassadors for education and preparedness to ensure a safer America. The FBI Dallas CAAA is a private, nonprofit organization that is separate and apart from the FBI.

### **The Scholarship Program**

For the first time since its inception in 2013 we will be awarding two scholarships this year. They are offered to current high school senior, college freshman or college sophomores, who are in good academic standing, demonstrate leadership, community service, are of good character, and interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement/criminal justice. Each \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in two installments of \$500.

### **Qualifications**

- US citizenship
- State of Texas resident
- High school senior, college freshman or college sophomore (in 2019-2020 school year)
- 3.0 grade point average or higher
- Attending or planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college/university in the Fall of 2020
- Dependents of FBI employees are not eligible to apply

### **Award**

The recipients will be announced in August 2020. He or she will receive the first installment upon providing documentation of registration from the college/university stated on their application. The second installment will be provided upon registration documentation for the second semester.
